In conjunction with the Swiss Benevolent Society of Philadelphia, the Swiss Benevolent Society of New York offers the following scholarship programs for Swiss-American students residing in New York, New Jersey, Connecticut, Delaware and Pennsylvania.

SBS Merit Scholarship — The SBS Merit Scholarship, formerly known as "Pellegrini Scholarship -merit only", is a partial tuition grant, which is based on merit alone (cumulative Grade Point Average of at least 3.0). It is awarded at the post-secondary school level for vocational or undergraduate and graduate academic studies at a college or university accredited by the U.S. Department of Education. SBS Outstanding Scholastic Achievement (OSA) Award — This award may be granted to a college senior or graduate student who demonstrates sustained academic excellence (cumulative Grade Point Average of at least 3.8) in a demanding study program. The college or university must be accredited by the U.S. Department of Education. To check whether your school is accredited please visit: https://ope.ed.gov/dapip/

SBS Graduate Award — SBS Graduate Awards will be granted to graduate students with the highest cumulative Grade Point Average. The SBS Graduate Award is a one-time only award. The college or university must be accredited by the U.S. Department of Education. To check whether your school is accredited please go the following website: https://ope.ed.gov/dapip/

Eligibility

Applicants or one of their parents must be Swiss national, permanently domiciled in New York, New Jersey, Connecticut, Pennsylvania or Delaware and of good academic standing. Application deadlines and required supporting documents

Please ensure your application and supporting documents are received by March 31, 2025:

- Proof of Swiss citizenship of applicant or one parent or guardian.
 Acceptable documents include: Copy of Swiss passport; Letter of recognition from a Swiss Consulate or Embassy.
- Proof of applicant's U.S. citizenship or U.S. residency.
- Proof of cost for tuition, room and board.
- If available, we recommend that you submit SAT/ACT or GRE/GMAT results.

Please also ensure the documents listed below are received by April 30, 2025:

- Official transcripts of all high school, college and graduate grades (no copies)
- Current Letters of Reference (one if applying for the SBS Merit Scholarship, and/or two for the SBS OSA and Graduate Awards). These must be must be written by the school principal, guidance counselor, or professor. No copies will be accepted.

Applications and supporting documents submitted past the deadline will not be considered.

The SBS does not confirm receipt of applications to students.

Application fee

There is a non-refundable application fee of \$75.00. This fee is due by **March 31st, 2025** and must be paid for the application to be considered. Payments must be made online: https://sbsny.org/scholarships/payment
